after inspection pretty rotten
band not fit to blow candles
out, meet girls afterwards, get kids,
and I take them to mess. Arrive by
C.G.D. 3 p.m. Find Katie McNeill in
the crowd can hardly believe
my eyes at first, her sweet enough
thought introduces me to Mrs. Miss Glynn
We all go to see the trenches. Then
I see the girls off and go back to
farewell dinner to the 9th pretty
tame saw very good speech by Major Allen

JANUARY, 1916.

Saturday 8

Bugle calls get out of bed
4.30 for once in a way I got straight
out. The Sigs leave by the 806
train I am in charge of the de
tails and don't go till 10.15 run straight
through to Te Ano, wait a dice
of a time on wharf get on board at
12.30. Make a bolt back up town &
have dinner at Pier Hotel with K
party: get back in time for march through
city 2.30 see quite a lot of people
know. get on board and after a lot of
jelling etc cast off 5.30 and go out
into the stream. Telegram by board
from home wishing good luck similar one from
Lutherlands. can not find any means
of getting ashore so go to bed.

JANUARY, 1916.

1st after Epiphany. Sunday 9

Wakened 4.50 by Joe saying he
kinks my bed say Bill we are off
look out the window and
see water and land moving
or appearing to do so. We
turn straight West which settles
the trip to Akhd. bit choppy
out side quite a crowd get
sick. we start to leave the
"Warimoo" about midday.
lose sight of N.Y. 3.30 p.m.
weather very calm, nothing
doing after church parade
3.30. sit round & read
dinner, read, and go to bed.
Tahiti left 4 hours ahead
of us some say she has gone
to Auckland. In morning received
telegram from Bay. Jim Bill letter from
Rec. J.M.K+H
